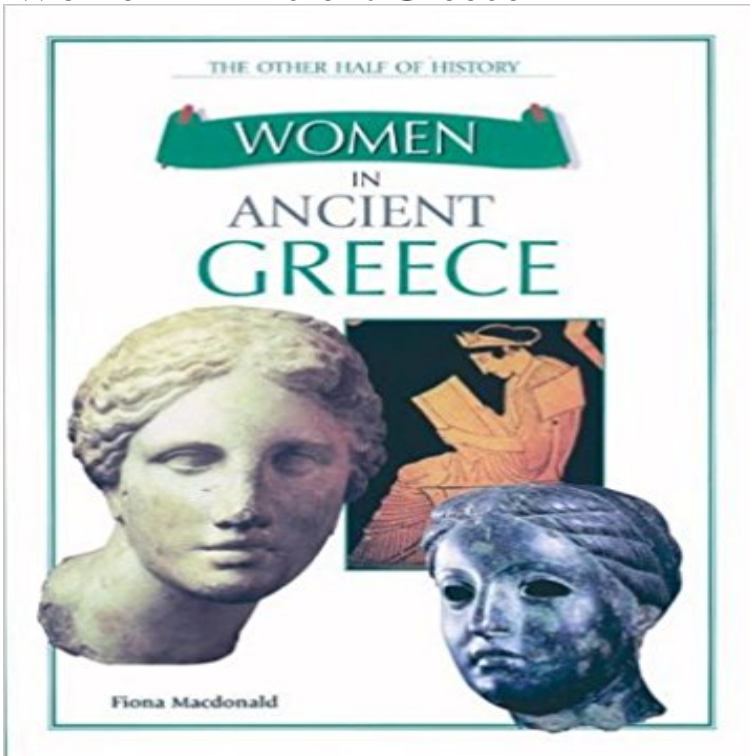


# Women in Ancient Greece
