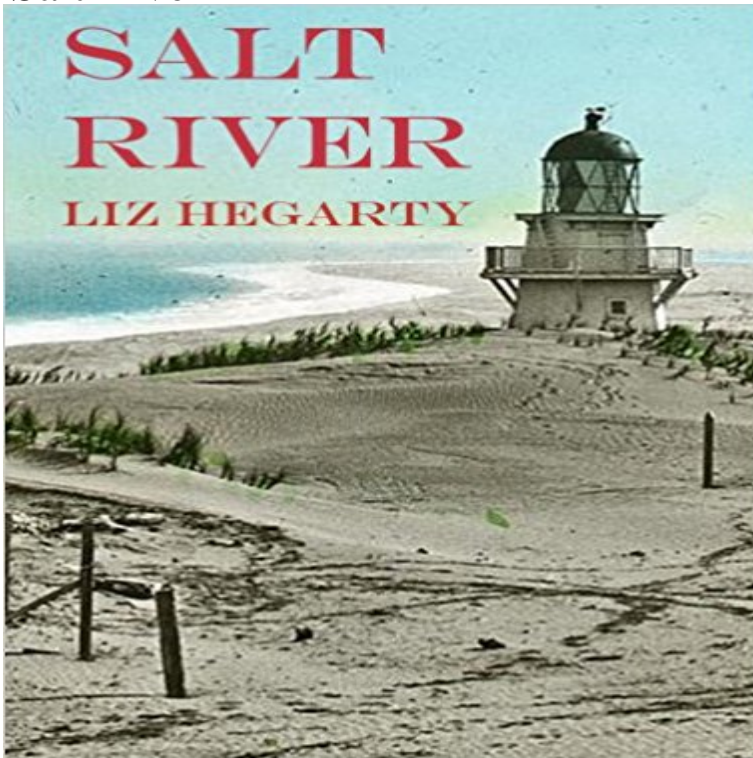


Salt River
