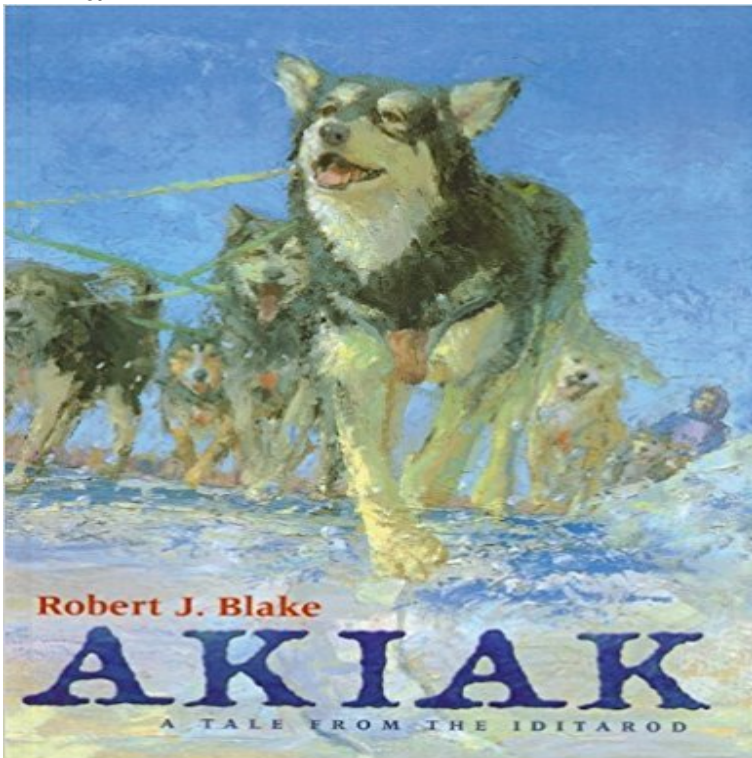


# Akiak
