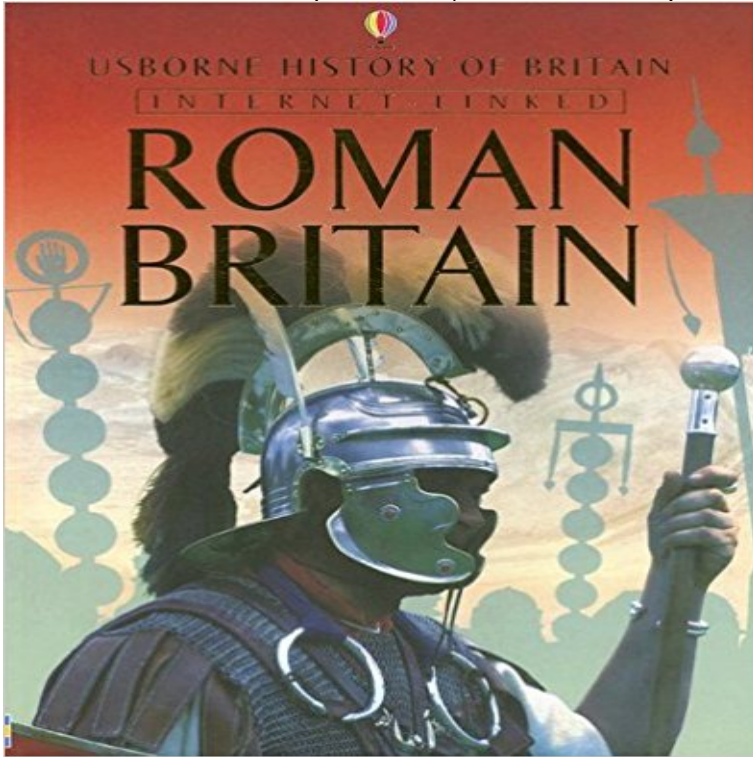


Roman Britain (History of Britain)
