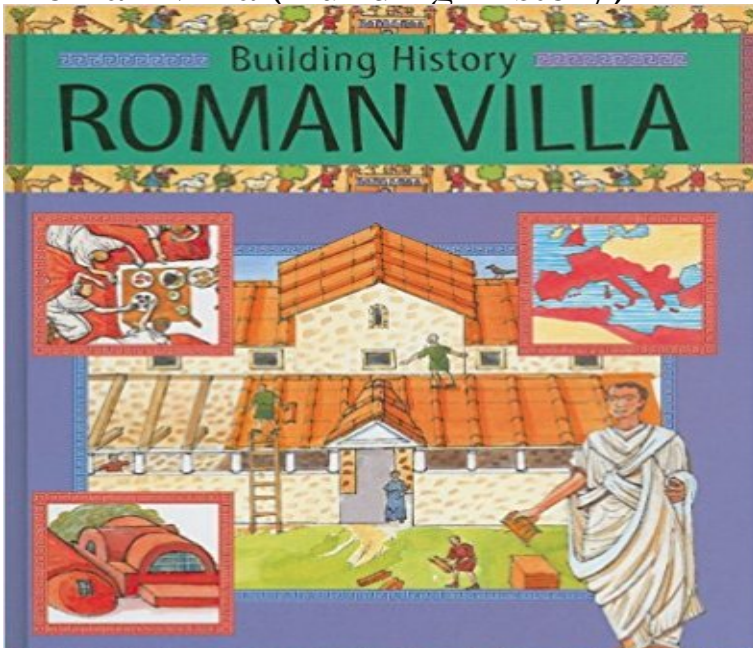


Roman Villa (Building History)
